\$15 kickstarts support for a Property Project being prayerfully contributed to by our Mission in Victoria Ladies Group (for example, a kitchen renovation at the Hope of Life Baptist Church in Sunshine).

Mission in Victoria Property Projects



\$125 provides at least one session of counseling for a pastor/pastor and partner or family member in need of assistance.



\$20 provides a subsidy for a rural pastor to attend a city training event that he or she might otherwise not be able to attend.

\$200 provides one week's rent for a family recently arrived in Australia through our Refugee Airfare Loans Scheme. RALS effectively supports refugees in their travel to a new life in Australia, but assistance post arrival is very limited.



\$50 provides a free home style meal for 10 people through the community meals program already operating at one of our BUV churches in these times of unprecedented need. For many, breaking bread together in this way, the community meal will be the only meal they have that day.



\$500 provides a secondhand laptop for a BUV pastor with no means to purchase one. We do have pastors in situations of very limited stipend support; some are not able to secure things such as laptops or mobile phones which have become essential in ministry.



\$75 helps a struggling but missional playgroup in one of our churches to purchase resources to enhance the program and the sense of belonging for those who come.

\$750 keeps a BUV Rural Regional Minister on the road visiting churches and pastors for a month. Rev Stephen Venz (West) and Rev Grant Stewart (East) are on the road for many days each week, covering hundreds of kilometers for the average visit.
