Regional Pastors:

Victoria has been divided into regions: East, West, and South-East Metropolitan and North-West Metropolitan. Each region has a Regional Pastor whose role is to help pastors in their region to have strong support and accountability networks that sustain them in ministry and attend to ongoing growth and development. Regional Pastors are also a "first point of call" in times of crisis and transition for pastors.

Pastoral Care through Groups

Peer Support Groups:

Peer support groups, clusters and networks of pastors for mutual encouragement and growth are an important feature of BUV life. All pastoral leaders are encouraged to be part of a pastoral cluster. It doesn't have to be geographical or Baptist but it does need to be regular, intentional, trustworthy and open to growing together. Where clusters are geographical, it enables cooperation in local mission. If you would like to be part of such a group, talk to your Regional Pastor who may help you to find one... or start one!

Next Gen:

A range of pastoral care opportunities – including mentoring, training, prayer retreat, crisis support – are available for emerging leaders, and Generations Pastors (Children and Families, Youth and Young Adults). Care of Experienced in Ministry:

The "Experienced in Ministry" group provides pastoral care to those who are 65 years of age and over, in retirement or widows/widowers of pastors. A quarterly magazine is also produced. Nourish:

Personal and Marital Counselling:
