



Day 2 – Dangerous Prayers for Dangerous Times

Prayer

As we pray this prayer today, we are giving Jesus the opportunity to search the entire house – not just one room, not just one closet – the whole house. But this is not something to be fearful of, because this act of surrender demonstrates how much we need Jesus, and also need Him to search us so that what is hidden can come to light. It shows us what He needs to forgive, transform and redirect in order to make us new.

I know that this is not an easy prayer to pray, but after David earnestly prayed this prayer, he became known as a man after God's own heart. As you pray this prayer today, I pray that as God's people we would all be known as those after God's own heart. As He searches each one of us, I pray He would forgive, transform and make us new.

Let's pray:

“Search me, God, and know my heart”

- Now pray it again and as you do open your hands in front of you posturing yourself as open as you are able. Breathe in deeply and allow God to move in you.
- As He begins to move in you what do you feel Him putting His finger on? (it might be good to have a journal next to you to write down what you feel Him saying to you).
- If God brings something or someone to mind – allow God to bring it to light and ask Him to forgive you and minister to you. Allow the Holy Spirit to surround you, guard you and hold you close as He searches you.

Close by praying “God know my heart. Heal my heart and make me new”.

Pray also for:

- The members of your group and their concerns
- The three people you have committed to pray for each day who are not followers of Jesus
- The April 14th BUV Calendar prayer - Protection for pregnant women and children”
