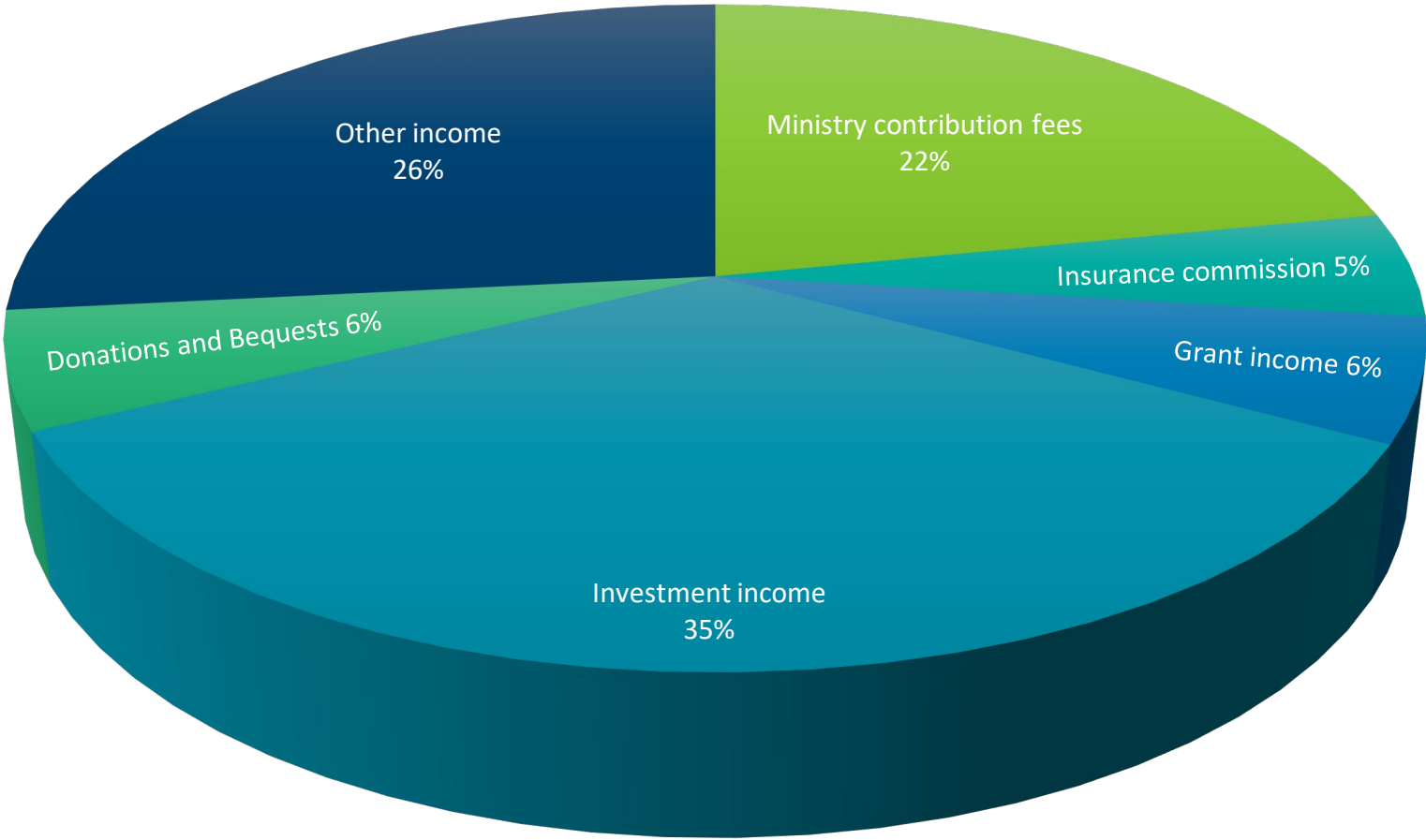

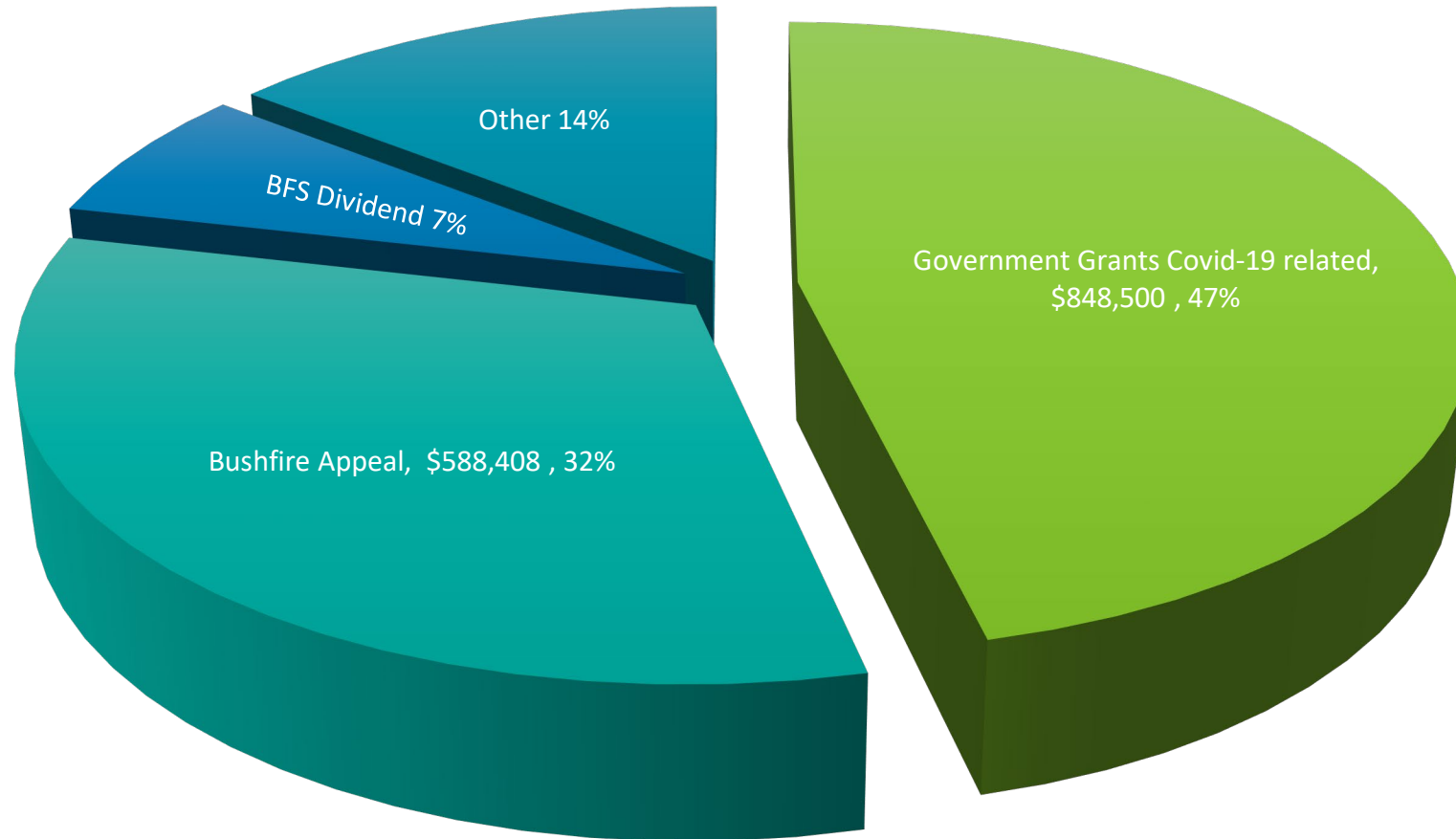

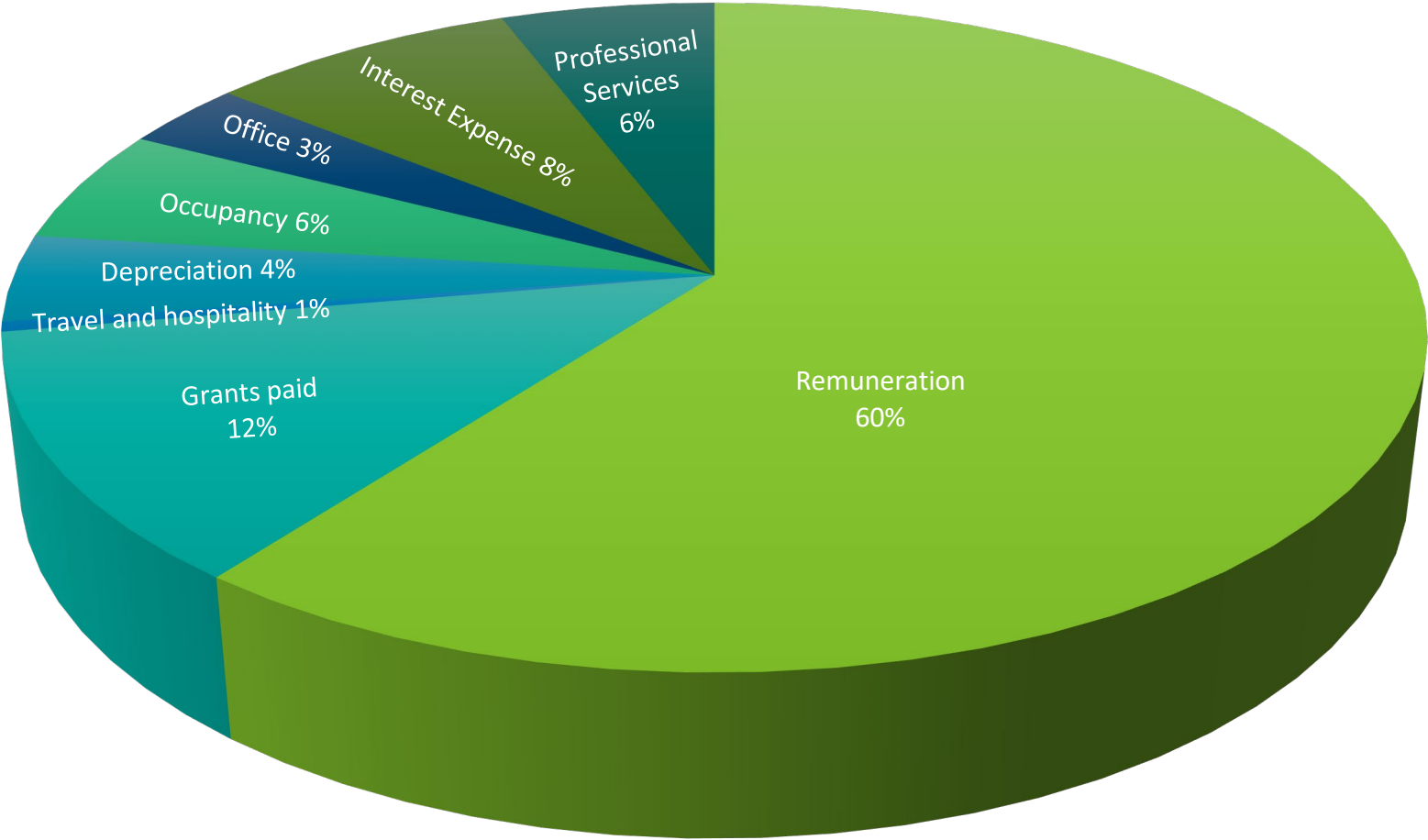
2020 Revenue
