



CrimCheck is the **only not-for-profit** organisation providing National Criminal History Checks (also called Police Checks). CrimCheck provides a fast, secure and affordable way to submit (National Criminal History Checks) Australia Wide via the National Police Checking Service Database. Checks, include providing identity documents, can be submitted totally online via your church's customised self-service portal, or submitted on paper. These checks are suitable for staff, leaders and volunteers within BUV churches and missional communities.



ACCREDITED

CrimCheck is accredited by the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC)

The BUV already utilises CrimCheck for managing BUV staff police checks, and all local churches and missional communities are welcomed and encouraged to consider using this service also.

The local church does not need to sign a service agreement with CrimCheck or provide an ABN. The details required are simply the details of the church and who will be in charge of the branch (local Church) account. It is free to open an account. The only charge – ever – is the cost of submitting a police check (**\$35.50/paid staff** and **\$16.00/volunteer check**).



SECURED

CrimCheck are committed to data security and review and audit our software and service delivery infrastructure consistently to ensure industry best practice.

Neither the BUV, nor other local churches, will be able to view any details from another local church. The only person who has access to an individual's police check is the individual who applied and the person in charge of their local church's CrimCheck account (called the administrator).

Please note:

Each local church is required to manage police check of all relevant staff, leaders and volunteers independently, and is not obliged to use CrimCheck.

BUV also recommends Oho (formerly dutyof.care) which is a different company who manages only Working with Children Checks (WWCC). CrimCheck provides an online system for local churches to manage their own team's Police Checks.

**Police check is a pre-paid service and must be paid for in advance either using a credit card or electronic bank transfer (EFT). Either the church can absorb the cost for all checks (write YES), or, every individual pays for their own (write NO)*

Once CrimCheck support team receives all details requested CrimCheck will activate the account and send the CrimCheck client “log in” details, as well as a training webinar, to the local church’s administrator.
